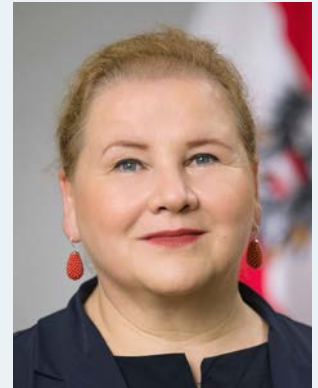


Federal Minister Korinna Schumann
